The composer Alexander l'Estrange has written and arranged many works for choirs. The Junior Choir sang his arrangements of Irish Folk Songs in our last concert before Easter. The songs that make up the collections Love's Philosophy are settings of celebrated texts by well-known poets. They are original compositions by Alexander following the long tradition of part songs by English composers. Other examples in today's programme include The Holst settings and the Rutter.
